HARE: COL MUSTARD

DATE: Saturday May 16, 2009

TIME: All Day (Sunrise 5:33 AM - Sunset 8:15 PM - Twilight 8:47 PM local Stoughton time)

Annual Syttende Mai 3 Mile Aid Station and Start of the Water-to-Beer Run

TIME: 7:00 AM – the race starts at 7:30 - **Water-to-beer run starts around 7:15**

PLACE: Meet near the corner of Rimrock Rd. and Rusk St. between the Dane County Coliseum and the beltline. Bring plastic pitchers and larger tables if you have them. With enough help we can be all done by about 8:15 in plenty of time to get to the BEER CHECK.

Annual Syttende Mai Hash Beer Check

TIME: Immediately after the aid station closes.

PLACE: Just 100 yards south from the corner of Schneider and Hawkinson. Take Highway 51 south past McFarland (but before Stoughton) and turn right on Schneider (marked by a large green sign for the UW Radiation Lab). Take Schneider to the corner of Hawkinson and park at the top of the hill before reaching the the race course. Look south, down the hill to find the beer check.

Annual Syttende Mai Hash Run

+++ Time 3:00 PM - NOTICE START TIME! Hash Cash \$5

Place: Mandt Park, Stoughton - Drive to downtown Stoughton on Main St., cross the bridge and turn right (south) on 4th St. Find the park just a few blocks south of Main St. It's the finish area for the race. Bucket showers available back at the On-On (see below).

Those not running the Hash Run can proceed directly to 828 St. Hwy 138 South. Hwy 51 and Hwy 138 merge together at the west edge of Stoughton to form Main Street. Take this about .75 miles through town to the point where 138 turns south. Take this a little over a mile to 828, the driveway will be on your right. Feel free to arrive early any time between the race/beer check and the hash. Designated drivers are recommended. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to camp. If camping - come and set up whenever you want. Hot tubs will be available and are clothing optional. Wear what you like but wash it in plain water beforehand to avoid "clogging the jets" on the tub. Bring your towels and take them back.

Food: Deserts Welcome – Col Mustard will provide the rest.

On-On schedule will be something like:

Beer, hot tub and sauna starting at 3:00 - Food about 5:00 - Small bonfire after ceremonies unless too cold

HASH HISTORY– RUN #1654 – ~~UNDIE's First Underwater~~ Outdoor Barbeque of Spring

Well, he'll have to keep trying since this year the weather was cold with pouring rain. This didn't get in the way of the plans though, after all... We Are Hashers! A small group showed up for a small run and a picnic style barbeque that included the world's best potato salad. More on this next time after the reporter's notes dry out.

May 3 Adopt-a-Highway Clean-up: LORENA CARROT took the lead. There were about 10 of us. 3-Holer and Dribs got a rash. We did good.

HASH HISTORY– RUN #1655 – Dos de Mayo Multicultural Run – Reported by Me Expone Beautiful weather! Large turn-out! Coincidence? I bet the two are related!

This run featured large numbers of new boots and a few seldom sees from everywhere. Pre-run instructions had to be given in three languages. Orjazzm brought her sister, Mayu, who arrived from Japan just that morning. ShowMe brought her (born in the USA) Latino friend, just Sara. There was a big group of male new boots: Tom, Dick, Harry, Larry and Moe (or something like that) and their friend from Sweden, Just Sven, along with seldom sees Can't Come Enough, Beats It Red and Cums and Goes.
